Contemporary Literature | Questioning the Text for Deeper Analysis [RESOURCE]

Level 1 - A question that has a concrete answer. Avoid these in discussions, unless you are clarifying a confusion. Examples:

Who are the King and the Duke?

Who rescues the boys from the island?

Level 2 - Interpretive questions that relate directly to the text. Interpretive means that they are a matter of opinion and can be answered differently. Examples:

What does the green light symbolize?

Who is most responsible for the hysteria in Salem?

Level 3 - Go beyond the book and ask about big picture ideas. These are questions that are universal and can connect to our world. Connection to the text should be apparent. Examples:

Is there ever such a thing as too much ambition?

Is technology's impact on our society positive or negative?

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
